What we will be learning about:

- Living things and their habitats
- Anglo-Saxons
- Healthy living

- The value of digits numbers up to 10,000 and addition and subtraction using these numbers
- How to produce beautiful handwriting and write a correctly punctuated sentence

- Becoming a class team, rights and responsibilities and being a school citizen

You can help by:

What we will be doing:

- Writing correctly formed and punctuated sentences
- Reading, writing and comparing numbers to 10,000, and learning how to add and subtract efficiently
- Making jewellery inspired by Anglo-Saxon artifacts
- Preparing and making a healthy dish
- Grouping and classifying animals using classification keys

Things to remember:

- Bookbags should be brought into school every Thursday.
- Children receive homework every Friday and it is checked the following Thursday.
